4. Serve as a venue for mathematics teachers, teacher educators, and researchers to work together and share their knowledge in teaching approaches and research that could contribute to an improved mathematics education in the country and throughout the world.

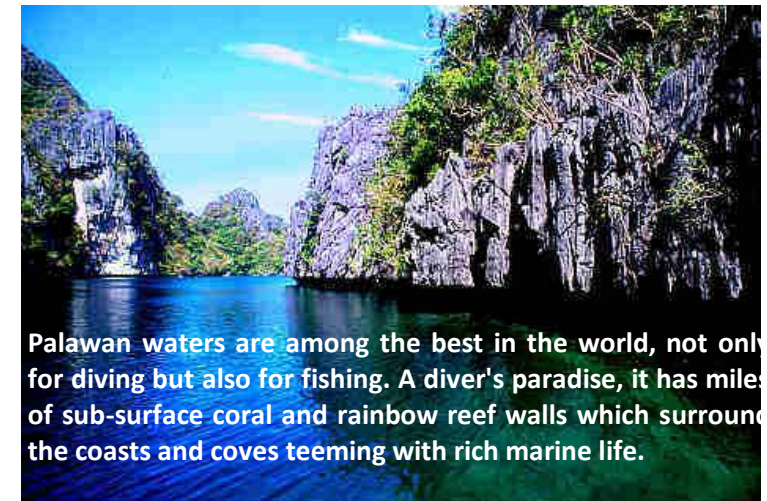
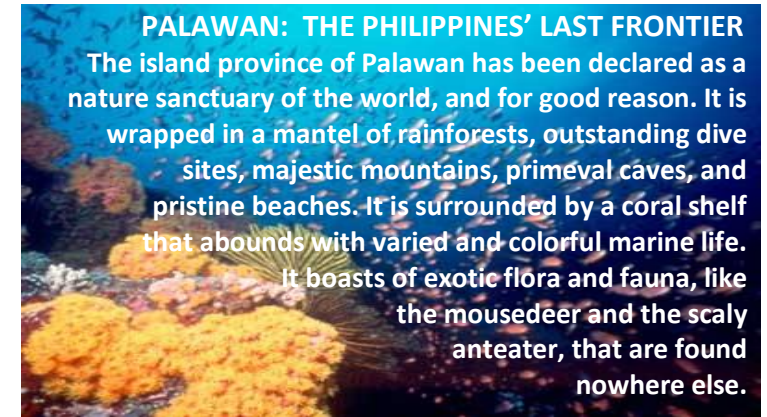
We are now accepting paper presentation proposals in the form of an abstract for the conference. We especially encourage empirical research and classroom-based research studies on curriculum innovations, new approaches in pedagogy and assessment, mathematics teacher preparation and professional development, instrument and materials development, and successful use of technology in mathematics instruction, among others. Papers that discuss prospective theoretical frameworks and new models in the teaching and learning of and assessment in mathematics are likewise highly acceptable.

Abstracts should have approximately 250 words and must clearly state the problem or thesis being addressed, the methodology, results, and implications.

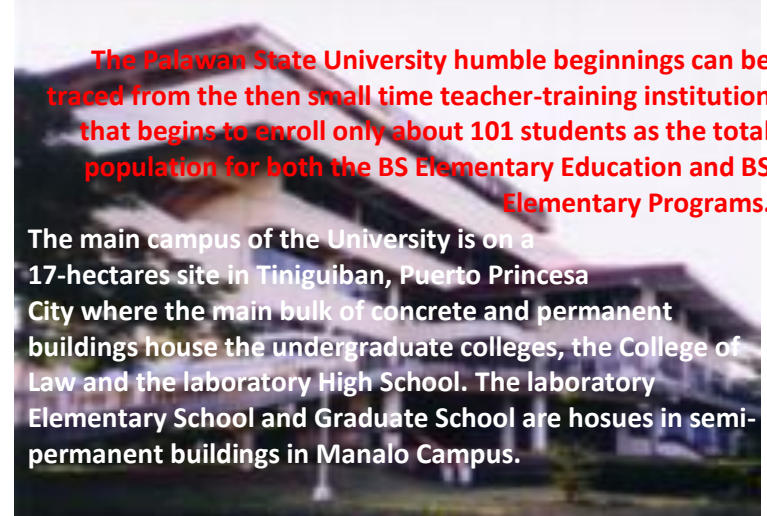
The heading should include the title of the paper, the name, institution, postal address, telephone number, email address, fax number, and mobile phone number of the author(s). Proposals should be received no later than **July 31, 2009**. Proponents of accepted papers shall be notified on or before **August 30, 2009**. The Conference Proceedings will be printed in time for the conference. Thus, soft copies of full papers to be printed in the proceedings must be received no later than **September 15, 2009**. Papers for the proceedings must be single-spaced, typed in 12-pt Times Roman font, must not exceed 8 pages, and are in accordance with the American Psychological Association (APA) style of writing manuscripts. Deadlines will be strictly followed.
