Migration of insects and birds through a Pyrenean pass

Port de Gavarnie, 50 yds wide, 7500' . 13 Oct 1950

E. balteatus flying steadily WSW against wind keeping extremely close to ground. Very few one settled for a moment. At least 20x and perhaps 100x as numerous as dragonfly migrants (passing at rate of at least several 1000 hr⁻¹).

Can find no previous recs of syrphid migrants, only large swarms, migration = directed movement indep of wind.
