

Proposed Changes to the Connector Pages handling of Navigation options.

Current situation.

The top level element of a Connector page includes the following options.


Navigation on Exit	Show all navigation buttons
Next / Continue Button	Hide Next and Continue Buttons
Back Button	Hide Back Button
Progress Button	Hide Progress Button
Contents Button	Hide Table of Contents

Proposal

1. Navigation on Exit will be removed. (All Connection pages will in future reset project Navigation on Exit by following a Connection to show all navigation buttons).
2. The 4 options for controlling the individual elements of the navigation that are displayed whilst viewing the Connector page will be removed and replaced by a **single none-optional property**

This Page Navigation (No Navigation / All Navigation Buttons) default will be No Navigation

3. Some Connector pages offer the facility for defining the Navigation on Exit (i.e. the navigation that will be available for the destination page) for each individual Connection defined in the page. Currently this is managed by offering four separate optional properties

4. This will be replaced by a **single none-optional property**
Navigation on Exit (Back and Next Only / All Navigation Buttons) default will be All Navigation Buttons.

This will have the effect of significantly simplifying the navigation setup whilst also avoiding potentially inappropriate options being configured.
